#### # FinanceTracker

A lightweight Windows desktop app for exploring stock prices and company financials.

Type a company name (smart dropdown search), fetch historical prices, hover the chart for a li crosshair/tooltip, and export prices or financial reports to CSV. Data is fetched via yfinance Finance).

## ## Highlights

- □ Smart search: start typing a company name (after 2—3 letters) and pick from suggestions.
- □ Interactive chart: crosshair follows the mouse; floating date/price bubble.
- [] Financials viewer: Income Statement / Balance Sheet / Cash Flow -- Annual or Quarterly, fi year/quarter.
- □ Export: save prices or financials to CSV.
- □ Modern UI: dark theme matching the app's palette.

#### ## Download & Install

- 1. Get the ZIP from https://softwaretools.online (Downloads page).
- 2. (Optional) Verify checksum:

powershell

certutil -hashfile .\FinanceTracker-<version>-win64.zip SHA256

Compare with the SHA256-...txt we publish.

- 3. Right-click → Extract All… (don't run from inside the ZIP).
- 4. Open FinanceTracker.exe.

# Requirements

- Windows 10 or 11 (64-bit)
- Internet connection
- ~80-200 MB free disk space
- No admin rights needed

## ## How to Use

### ### Prices tab

- 1. In Company, start typing ( $\geq$ 3 letters) → pick from the dropdown; or type a Ticker directly.
- 2. Choose Period (e.g., 6mo, 1y) and Interval (e.g., 1d, 1h).
- 3. Click Fetch.
- 4. Hover the chart to see date/price; use Save CSV to export; Clear to reset.

#### ### Financials tab

- 1. The selected company carries over from Prices.
- 2. Pick Report (Income Statement / Balance Sheet / Cash Flow).
- Choose Frequency (Annual / Quarterly).
- 4. Select Year and (if Quarterly) a Quarter, then Load Financials.
- 5. Use Save CSV to export the table.

# ## Data Source & Limits

- Data comes from Yahoo Finance via yfinance and may be delayed or incomplete.
- Intraday history and some tickers/exchanges may have limited coverage.
- If a fetch returns nothing, try a longer period or a coarser interval.

Not investment advice. Use at your own risk.

## ## Privacy

- No sign-in and no telemetry.
- Your data stays local; the app only makes outbound requests to Yahoo endpoints to fetch mark

## Troubleshooting
```

- SmartScreen / "Unknown Publisher": Click More info → Run anyway. New unsigned apps can trigg they build reputation.
- Antivirus quarantine: This ZIP ("one-dir") format is generally AV-friendly. If flagged, add folder to your AV's exclusions/allowlist.
- Empty or partial chart: Use a longer Period or higher Interval; check your internet connectifirewalls/proxies may block requests.
- Search finds nothing: Type at least 3 letters. For some exchanges include suffixes (e.g., ISTSLA).
- Uninstall: Just delete the extracted folder and any shortcuts. No registry entries. ## Keyboard Tips
- Company field: ↓ to focus suggestions, Enter to select the first suggestion.
- Esc closes the suggestions list.

## Verifying Downloads (SHA-256)

Windows PowerShell:

powershell

Get-FileHash .\FinanceTracker-<version>-win64.zip -Algorithm SHA256

Compare with SHA256-FinanceTracker-<version>.txt published on the site.

python -m PyInstaller --noconfirm --clean --windowed --onedir

- --add-data "assets;assets"
- ".\light finance app.py"
